Delhi CM meets citizen during Jan Sunwai

Delhi Chief Minister Rekha Gupta on Wednesday met with the citizens from various parts of the Capital during a *Jan Sunwai* (public hearing) held at the Mukhyamantri Jan Seva Sadan. She listened attentively to people's problems, complaints, and suggestions, and issued clear instructions to officials of the concerned departments to take immediate action. The Chief Minister stated that ensuring the timely resolution of public issues is the Government's highest priority. She directed officials to act on every complaint with sensitivity and urgency so that citizens receive their rights and access to public services on time. During the hearing, the Chief Minister personally interacted with the complainants, assuring them that their concerns and suggestions would be addressed as quickly as possible.

Govt sanctions ₹610.27 crore project for MCD

The Delhi Government has sanctioned an ₹610.27 crore project for the MCD to roll out mechanised sweeping, enhance construction waste management, and introduce battery-operated litter pickers. Under the plan, the Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) will modernise 106 primary construction and demolition (C&D) waste collection centres with barricading, CCTV surveillance, water sprinklers, air quality sensors and information boards to minimise dust emissions, an official said. Delhi Environment Minister Manjinder Singh Sirsa said that the Environment Department approved the project on Monday under the leadership of Chief Minister Rekha Gupta in a move to tackle dust pollution and improve sanitation across the national Capital. The minister said the administrative approval covers three key projects – upgrading C&D waste collection sites, procuring mechanical road sweeping machines, and deploying battery-operated litter picker vehicles to enhance waste management efficiency in market areas and narrow lanes.

Delhi Police organises workshop Cyber-Samvaad for teachers

The Delhi Police on Wednesday organised a workshop titled "Cyber-Samvaad" for school teachers. The event, held at Adarsh Auditorium in the Police Headquarters on Jai Singh Road, was conducted in collaboration with the Indian Cybercrime Coordination Centre (I4C) of the Ministry of Home Affairs and the Directorate of Education, Government of Delhi.

The three-hour session brought together around 350 computer teachers from various city schools. The focus was to educate them on the methods used by cybercriminals and train them in preventive measures.

Govt to develop world-class sports grounds in schools

Giving a boost to sports infrastructure in the national Capital, Delhi Government will develop state-of-the-art sports grounds equipped with modern facilities in Government schools across the city.

Announcing this on Wednesday, Chief Minister Rekha Gupta said the initiative aims to provide children with quality sports training from an early age so they can make Delhi and the nation proud at national and international events.

She held a high-level meeting with the Education Department to review departmental activities and directed officials to prepare a detailed blueprint for this ambitious plan. Senior officials from the Chief Minister's Office were also present at the meeting.

The Chief Minister stated that to strengthen Delhi's sports ecosystem, the Government will collaborate with various reputed sports academies. Under this initiative, Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) will be signed for training in disciplines such as cricket, boxing, taekwondo, football, swimming, and others. These academies will be provided access to sports facilities and administrative support to run structured training programmes.

According to the Chief Minister, the goal is to ensure that children receive professional sports coaching from an early age, enabling them to pursue their ambitions with discipline and confidence. She emphasised that

She announced that the Delhi Government awards ₹7 crore for Olympic gold medalists, ₹5 crore for silver medalists, and ₹3 crore for bronze medalists. In addition, promising athletes at the state and national levels will receive financial assistance and Government employment opportunities.

Toxic air continues to envelope Delhi

The national Capital continued to breathe toxic air on Wednesday with pollution levels remaining 'severe' for the second straight day at 418, as stubble-burning in the neighbouring regions contributed most to Delhi's foul air.

Delhi's Air Quality Index (AQI) remained 'severe' with the 24-hour average recorded at 418 at 4 pm, according to Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) data. A 'severe' AQI poses serious health risks even to healthy individuals, and can affect those with existing respiratory or cardiac conditions badly.

According to the Decision Support System (DSS) data, stubble-burning contributed 22.4 per cent to Delhi's PM2.5 concentration on Wednesday - the highest share from farm fires recorded so far this winter.

The share of pollution transported from outside the city stood at 15.5 per cent, the DSS data showed. Delhi recorded its first 'severe' air quality day of the season on Tuesday, with the overall AQI reaching 428. The air quality, which had been 'very poor' for several days, deteriorated further due to stagnant weather conditions and local emissions.

For Thursday, stubble-burning is projected to contribute around 10.1 per cent to Delhi's PM2.5 levels, while transport-related emissions are expected to increase slightly to 19.3 per cent, according to DSS projections.

Cold wave action plan prepared to protect vulnerable sections

The Delhi Government is firming up a cold wave action plan for the city, which includes preparing a hot-spot map and standard operating procedure to safeguard vulnerable sections, including the elderly, children, migrant workers, and the homeless.

The draft "Delhi Cold Wave Action Plan" prepared by the Delhi Disaster Management Authority (DDMA) has been forwarded to the respective departments for comments, a senior Delhi Government officer said.

According to the India Meteorological Department, a cold wave in the plains is considered when the minimum temperature of a

station drops to 10°C or less. The draft action plan emphasises establishing a standard operating procedure (SOP) for minimising the impact on health of high risk groups – senior citizens above 65 years, young children up to 5 years, homeless persons and those with chronic conditions.

Creating a standard cold wave treatment protocol, adequate arrangements of staff, beds and essential medicines in the hospitals were part of the action plan, he said. It has laid down responsibilities of various agencies, including Municipal Corporation of Delhi, Delhi Urban Shelter Improvement Board (DUSIB), Food and Civil Supply department and the public works department, among others, he said. The

draft also recommends rapid response teams to respond to any exigency call outside the hospitals.

The SOP also includes an emergency response plan for stray animals in an extreme cold wave, involving the identification of their shelter homes with the arrangement of food and fodder. A total of 197 shelter homes across the city, operated by DUSIB, will provide temporary accommodation and food during the adverse weather conditions.

Delhi Chief Minister Rekha Gupta last week announced that the Delhi Government's winter action plan will roll out from November 15 with 250 temporary and 197 permanent shelter homes prepared for homeless and needy people in the city.

Jhalkari Bai included in commemoration scheme

The Delhi Government on Wednesday approved the inclusion of freedom fighter Veerangana Jhalkari Bai Koli in its scheme for Commemoration of Birth and Death Anniversaries of Eminent Personalities. The decision was cleared at a Cabinet meeting chaired by Chief Minister Rekha Gupta.

Under the scheme, events are organised to honour national icons such as Dr BR Ambedkar, Sant Ravidas, Maharishi Valmiki, Sant Kabir, Sant Gadge Maharaj and Sant Durbal Nath. With the latest decision, Jhalkari Bai Koli's name has been added to the list. The scheme, run by the Department for the Welfare of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes, provides financial support to registered NGOs to organise commemorative events. The Government offers up to ₹50,000 per event.

The Chief Minister said the move recognises the courage and sacrifice of Jhalkari Bai Koli, who fought alongside Rani Lakshmi Bai during the 1857 revolt. "Veerangana Jhalkari Bai Koli symbolises the indomitable courage and spirit of India's freedom struggle. Her inclusion is a tribute to her immense contribution to the nation," she said.

Officials said several community groups had long demanded Jhalkari Bai Koli's inclusion. The Delhi Government's approval fulfils that demand and ensures her legacy receives due honour. The CM said the Government is committed to celebrating reformers, saints and freedom fighters. "This decision is not only administrative. It is an effort to strengthen equality and social justice," she said.

The Chief Minister added that recognising Jhalkari Bai Koli highlights the role of women in India's freedom struggle. ?
